

RULES GOVERNING THE PERSONAL IMPORT OF FOOD TO FIJI

Warning:

***Biosecurity is your responsibility. Heavy penalties apply.
If in doubt, declare it***

Personal Consumption

The Biosecurity Authority of Fiji (BAF) allows travellers to bring certain animal products into Fiji from Australia and New Zealand for personal consumption. The chart below identifies two classes of animal products: those that can be brought into Fiji without an import permit, and others that require an import permit.

Please note that for the permissible products listed in the chart below, there is a 10kg limit per product allowed into Fiji for personal use. To bring more than 10kg of any of these permissible products will require an Import Permit from BAF.

Restrictions

All imported animal products must come from a State or Federal Government registered abattoir, slaughterhouse, processing plant or manufacturing factory. Animal products from unregistered premises will not be allowed into Fiji.

Please note that to bring in any of the products listed below, a receipt is required from the supermarket/butcher/other retail outlet from which the product has been purchased.

To import pork and pork products from New Zealand and Australia, an import permit is required from BAF. Travellers seeking to import pork from other nations should inquire with BAF prior to departure.

Poultry products of Australian origin are presently NOT allowed entry into Fiji. However poultry products from New Zealand are allowed.

Honey imports are prohibited due to the threat of bacterial and parasitic diseases that afflict bees, which are present in many honey exporting countries.
